Below you will find specifics about each of these crews. Some crews have restrictions by age, some by height, and some by interests and abilities. Production Crews

Set Construction & Painting

Crew Head: Cordaé & Art

Number of Kids: 4 – 6

Age: 12-18

Time: June 18, 1 pm to 4 pm; June 20, 1 pm to 4 pm; June 25, 1 pm to 4 pm; June 27, 1 pm to 4 pm

These crew members will help build and paint the set and decorations for the theater. These kids may be operating drills, saws, etc.

Costumes

Crew Head: Julie

Number of Kids: 8-10, 4-5 in each group

Age: 10-18

Times: Group 1: May 29, 4:15 pm to 6:15 pm; June 17, 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm; June 19, 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm; June 24, 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm; June 26, 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm

Group 2: May 30, 4:15 pm to 6:15 pm; June 17, 3 pm to 4 pm; June 19, 3 pm to 4 pm; June 24, 3 pm to 4 pm; June 26, 3 pm to 4 pm

These crew members will help size, organize and make costumes.

Props

Age: 7-9

Times: Every day from June 17 to June 20 from 10 am to 11:30 am.

These crew members will make props for the show.

Age: 9-14

Skills: Creative

Times: June 11, 1 to 2 pm; June 14; 1 to 2 pm; June 24, 9:30 to 10:30 am*; July 8, 9 to 10:30 am*

These crew members will assist the Marketing Manager with writing the radio commercial, designing thank you notes and decorating the theater with cast pictures.

Photography

Age: 13-18

Times: Will vary. Photographers need to get pictures of rehearsals and crews listed on this sheet. Kids will work directly with the crew head to set up a schedule.

Run Crews

Curtain Puller

Crew Head: Sue & Miki

Number of Kids: 2 (one for each cast)

Age: 13-18

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

This crew member is responsible for opening and closing the curtain during rehearsals and performances.

Props Master

Crew Head: Sue & Miki

Number of Kids: 2 (one for each cast)

Age: 12-18

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

This crew member will be responsible for making sure the props are in their proper place backstage for rehearsals and performances.

Lights

Crew Head: Sue & Mike

Number of Kids: 2 (one for each cast)

Age: 15-18

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

This crew member is responsible for operating the stage lights during rehearsals and performances.

Sound

Crew Head: Sue & Mike

Number of Kids: 2 (one for each cast)

Age: 15-18

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

This crew member is responsible for operating the sound effects and the microphones during rehearsals and performances.

Spotlight

Crew Head: Sue & Mike

Number of Kids: 2 (one for each cast)

Age: 14-18

Restriction: Need to be 5 foot tall or taller

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

This crew member is responsible for operating the spotlight during rehearsals and performances.

Stage Managers

Crew Head: Sue & Miki

Number of Kids: 4 (two for each cast)

Age: 14-18

Times: Watch at least one rehearsal on either June 27 or June 28. Every rehearsal June 29 to July 10 and 7 performances.

These crew members are in charge backstage, making sure cast members are where they need to be, ready & in place for rehearsal & show and that everyone is safe.

Front of House Crews

House Manager

Crew Head: Donna

Number of Kids: 6-10

Age: 11 – 18

Times: Tuesday, July 9, 10 am to 11 am and two or more performances, arriving one hour before the show begins.

These crew members are in charge of the ushers and the safety of the patrons.

Ushers

Crew Head: Donna

Number of Kids: 30-60, 5-6 per performance

Age: 7 – 10

Times: Tuesday, July 9, 10 am to 11 am and one or more performances, arriving one hour before the show begins.

These crew members are in charge of making sure that audience members find their seats.

Concession

Crew Head: Donna

Number of Kids: 4-12, 2 per performance

Age: 12-18

Restriction: Need to be 5 foot tall or taller.

Skills: Must be good with money and making change and have good communication skills and be able to interact with people.

Times: Monday, July 8, 10:30 am to 11:00 am and two or more performances

These crew members will be selling candy and pop to the audience before the show and during intermission.

Box Office

Crew Head: Donna

Number of Kids: 4-12, 2 per performance

Age: 10-18

Restriction: Need to be 4 foot 5 inches tall or taller.

Skills: Must be good with money and making change and have good communication skills and be able to interact with people.

Times: Monday July 8, 2 pm to 2:30 pm and two or more performances

These crew members will be in charge of the tickets for the performance. They will pass out pre-ordered tickets and sell tickets to patrons.
